

# ELECTRICIAN APPRENTICESHIP CAREER PATHWAY

## PRE-ADMISSION

### MINIMUM APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS

*Electrician Apprenticeship applicants must meet the following requirements before applying :*

- Must be at least 18 years of age before the time of assignment for an apprenticeship (copy of birth certificate or driver's license required).
- Must be a high school graduate or have attained a general equivalency diploma (GED) before the time of assignment for an apprenticeship.
- Must have completed one full year of high school Algebra with a passing grade of 'C' or above, or one post-high school Algebra course with a grade of 'C' or above.
- Present or sign a statement that he or she is physically able to perform required work. Those who reach employable status must successfully pass a drug screen test before placement.
- Provide official transcripts of high school and post-high school courses.
- Must have the ability to get to school and work on a timely and consistent basis.

- Paid Instruction: One full day every two weeks during the school year
- Unpaid Instruction: Minimum of 200 hours of classroom instruction on apprentice's own time
- Pass State of Wisconsin journeyman's test.

### SELECTED CANDIDATES

#### APPRENTICE REQUIREMENTS:

- Training program lasts: 5 years
- On the job training: Minimum of 7,920 hours
- Paid Instruction: 720 hours of classroom instruction
- Unpaid Instruction: Minimum of 200 hours of classroom instruction on apprentice's own time
- Pass State of Wisconsin journeyman's test.
